First arrivals enjoying their evening meal – Eva, John, Elisabeth, Päivi, Steve, Sue, Graham and Matthias.



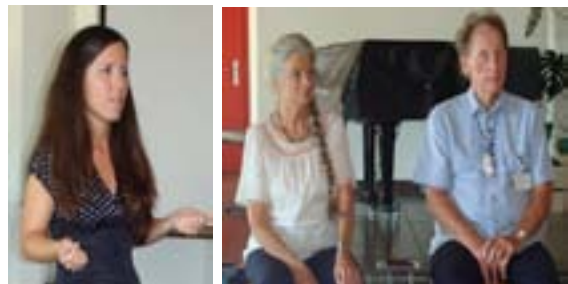
Ann and Annie decided to take a little tour of the countryside before arriving just in time for supper.

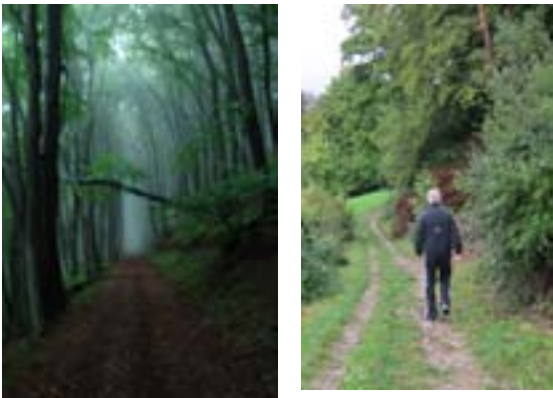
Here Carmen Fetzer spoke on 'How to Present Mediumship'

Forum East-Switzerland (PFO). They invited us to a Zürich lake front hotel for coffee & Swiss cake – a real treat.

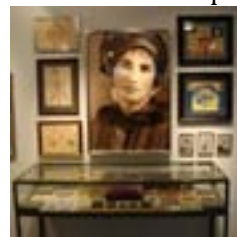


Finally a visit to the Emma Kunz grotto. A special place of power & vitality in an old Roman Quarry. It has become a spiritu-
